Also, someone from outside BSBC has donated money for the Guatemala team to have t-shirts to wear as we travel. Extra t-shirts are available for \$10 and can be purchased beginning Wednesday, July 11.

Outing to the Joy Performance Center in Kings Mountain to see *Liberty Mountain: The Revolutionary Drama* followed by dinner

"In September 1780, Major Patrick Ferguson issued a challenge to the rebel militias to lay down their arms or suffer the consequences. In response, people across Carolina, Virginia, Tennessee and beyond rallied together to answer Ferguson's threat and to fight for their freedom. They marched more than 300 miles through rugged country and weather to face a well-trained group of superior size and strength. What they did at Kings Mountain turned the tide of the American Revolution. Over 50 actors, technicians, designers, and volunteers bring *Liberty Mountain* to life."

This drama comes highly recommended! We will meet at church at 1:00 pm on **Saturday**, **July 19** to travel to see the matinee performance and we will stop for dinner at Love's Fish Box (they serve a variety of food-not just fish) on the return trip. Cost for the drama is **\$20.00** per person. Outing to Mars Hill University to see the professional world premiere of *I-YA-I-YA-O*, an original play by our own Dr. Doug Bryan

The protagonists are unconventional characters—speaking their minds, performing rituals, and conducting secret meetings. During a "truth ceremony," all parties could only tell the truth, leading to an interesting outcome.
