KEITH'S KORNER

A Pastor friend once told me the story of how he went to visit an older adult and shared with them that at their age they needed to be thinking about the hereafter. This person told my friend, "Oh, preacher, I do that all the time. No matter where I am, in the kitchen, living room, upstairs or down in the basement, I ask myself, now....what am I here after?"

I am thankful that because of Jesus Christ my hereafter is secure! In John 11:25-26, Jesus says, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die." As believers in Jesus Christ we will join together on Easter Sunday, March 27 and celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior. What a great day this will be!

As we prepare for Easter Sunday and for our Easter Cantata March 20, I challenge you to join me in inviting others to church. Tom Rainer, in his book *Unchurched Next Door*, says that 82 percent of the unchurched are at least "somewhat likely" to attend church if they are invited. Perhaps we need to restate it: More than eight out of ten of the unchurched said they would come to church if they were invited. History tells us that more people come to church during this Easter season than at any other time of the year. Let's join together and invite others in our community to hear the good news of God's love! The church office will soon have available a simple handout that can be used to invite others.

What a blessing to hear that many are listening to the New Testament! Whether you are a mature Christian, a new believer or would classify yourself as a seeker, I pray that our scripture listening would lead us all to, "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ" (I Peter 3:18). As we continue to listen to the NT I am aware that many are having questions about what they are hearing. If this is you and you would like to talk, I would welcome this opportunity. Also, I am exploring the possibility of a short-term class simply titled, "Q & A with the Pastor." This Q & A time could be during the Sunday School hour or at another time convenient for those interested. If you are interested in such a time please let me or the church office know.

In preparation for Easter I will be preaching a new sermon series, Jesus According to Jesus – A Look at the 'I Am' sayings of Christ. Also, our Wed. evening study on the Life of Jesus will continue as we seek to learn more about who He was (is) and why He came.

Download Bible Listening App

Purchase a Biblestick

Just 28 minutes a day for 40 days you can listen through the entire New Testament. Reading through the New Testament is a great goal, but have you ever listened to the entire New Testament? What a great way to prepare our hearts and minds for Easter! If you would like to join with others from BSBC to listen through the NT during the season of lent you are welcome to pursue one of the following options for doing this.

- -Pick up a copy of the New Testament on a free MP3 disc located in church office or at welcome desk in sanctuary lobby. A MP3 disc can be played in cars approximately 2007 and up, any CD player labeled MP3 compatible, on your computer or in your DVD player.
- -Download a Bible listening app to your smart phone or tablet. We recommend the free Bible.is app.
- -You can purchase a Biblestick listening device for \$24. An example of this can be found in the church office during the week or at the welcome desk in the church lobby on Sunday mornings. This is a very small device with comfortable ear buds that would work great while you are walking, etc.

PRESCHOOL AND CHILDREN NOTES...

As the month of February comes to a close the children would like to say thank you for allowing them to share their love with you. It is important for them to learn to tell others that they love them and to show their love as Jesus did. Through their love to others, they presented Nancy Freeman of Heart to Heart Ministry with love bags for the



children who reside at the mission. The bags had coloring books, crayons, a stuffed animal, and a pillow case on which the children had written messages of love. Congratulation to the GAs who also presented Nancy with a trunk load of paper supplies for the shelter. The children learned through Nancy's message how very fortunate and loved they are here at church and at home.

As the month of March begins, we look toward a change of season. As a new season begins for me, as Minister to Children and Preschoolers, I look forward to continuing to plant seeds for the children to learn more about Jesus but also to help them to continue to share their love and growth in Jesus. It is so important that the children learn what Easter really means to Christians and that Easter is the essence of the Christian faith.

MUSIC NOTES FROM ROGER LOWE

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. (Romans 10:17)

March brings us the season of Lent, Holy Week and Resurrection Sunday. Some observe Lent by giving up something, and posts on social media suggest everything from chocolate to indifference toward others. From humorous to serious, the idea is to set aside worldly things and be reminded of the nearness of a God and Savior that desires a relationship with us. Our lives are frequently so busy we never stop working on something, even if it's being busy trying to shut off the world long enough to collect our thoughts so we can tackle the next thing. The passage in Romans quoted above reminds us that it is important to hear the Word of God as well as to read it. Most ancient peoples were illiterate, and needed the Bible to be read to them. Indeed, the stories recorded in the Gospels were passed around in the ancient oral tradition for years after the resurrection before anyone wrote them down.

Listening to a song is a different experience from simply reading the lyrics, and there are things to be gained from learning by hearing. A most profound thing I experienced was at a funeral several years ago. One of the family members, an actor, read I Corinthians 13 in such a way that this completely familiar passage (Love is patient, kind,) took on new life and meaning. Hearing the scripture read with thought and feeling was a wonderful experience that day.

Boiling Springs Baptist has mp3 CDs available so that we may listen to the entire New Testament. There are also a number of apps for smartphones by which you can listen to the Bible being read. As hymn singing can open us to revelations of truth in Christ and what it means personally, so also can hearing the Word of God read aloud.

Our Music Makers report that they are having a great year, with eleven children on roll and an average attendance of eight. The children are learning the basic music theory of note shapes and corresponding time values, and the meanings of other symbols used in music. The kids are having a good time with Boomwhackers in an arrangement of *Amazing Grace*. If you aren't familiar with Boomwhackers, you will want to be here when they use them! The Music Makers choir is learning to sing parts as well, in the children's favorite, *The Wise Man and the Foolish Man*. Most importantly, our children are learning about their faith and Jesus' sacrifice for us in songs like *Here I Am to Worship*.

We would love to have more children take part in this fun learning experience. All of our children's choirs meet from 5:30-6:15 each Wednesday evening.




