From our Associate Pastor for Music & Adults... Candy Wilson

The Psalmist has challenged us to "sing a new song to the Lord." Every day, each moment of our lives is a new song waiting to be sung, played, whistled, or hummed. The season of Lent begins on Wednesday, February 14th. Lent is a good time to examine our individual "songs," or lives, and determine how we can best play, sing, whistle, or hum that which God has given us. The Psalmist has also said: "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name." When we offer our self, our total being to God in worship, we begin to experience the joy of the abundant life. In our corporate worship services, we can decide to participate more fully, sing the hymns more heartily, pray more fervently, and read the scripture with deep conviction.

It is a joy for me on Sundays when I look around the congregation and see children searching the hymnal for the correct hymn number, adults sharing their hymnals with children, and delight on the faces of everyone while singing those hymns. Eric Routley, 20th century hymnist, composer, and theologian said that a good hymn is one that is "well written, well chosen, and well sung." A vital element in congregational worship is hymn singing, for it is a time when the people of God unite in voicing their praise to the Creator. As our prayers and hymns ascend to our Maker, do we consider offering anything less than our best?

It will be a very special and joyful day of worship. *Plans are also underway for a special luncheon and session with Dr. Richardson following worship*.

Preschool and Children...

As we leave the month of January and go into February the children are going to focus on simple acts of kindness. They started "filling their buckets" with "Share the Warmth" night on Wednesday, January 24, during our mission study. We made scarves and hats for the women shelter and filled socks of love for the men's shelter. Each gift had a card or note attached that the pre-k kids decorated during their time with Miss E.

On Sundays during February we will have children's Bible study and mission activities from 5:00-6:00. We will focus on their individual "buckets" of kindness. During Bible study and while working on simple acts of kindness, the children will put into action simple acts of kindness that will help them learn to "fill their bucket!" A simple act of kindness can say a lot more than a gift.

Jesus showed all of us how kindness can move each of us. Through learning Bible verses the children will see how Jesus demonstrated kindness. The list of acts of kindness can almost be endless. Things as simple as saying "hello" or "thank you" can sometimes ease a troubled heart or make the lonely person feel welcomed. This is a lesson each of us, but especially the children, need to learn.

In the end we all need to recognize that the ultimate act of kindness was Jesus giving his life for each of us. That is the lesson our children must hear.

Won't you join the children in doing acts of kindness? There will be a kindness tree with small buckets for acts of kindness near the lighthouse. If you see a child who has done an act of kindness, please place a note on the tree or in a bucket to acknowledge the child's action. This will encourage the child to be gracious and loving and to follow the example of Christ.

Be a bucket filler! It will be good for you and for our children.


