#### ~MISSIONS OPPORTUNITIES~

**The Food Pantry** has continued and will continue to operate during the pandemic. We have received numerous generous donations that have helped us to provide food for those in our area who are in need throughout this entire year and with extras at Thanksgiving.

**The December Missions Offering** for missions around the world is another opportunity for us to spread the gospel. You have the opportunity to give through the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF) Global Missions offering and/or the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) Lottie Moon offering. The Ingathering for the offering will be celebrated on December 27, but you are welcome to give to these missions opportunities at any time.

**Our Christmas Cards for Faithful Saints** emphasis is a way we can connect with those who may be homebound or not able to be as active as they once were. The list of recipients can be found elsewhere in this newsletter. This year you may place your cards in a bag (be sure to label it) and leave them in the Prayer Room. The church staff will see to it that the cards are delivered. Please bring your cards no later than Wednesday, December 16.

As we prepare our hearts to give to international missions, we consider two scriptures:

**Revelation 7:9-10** – "After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" **Matthew 16:24** – "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."

At Boiling Springs Baptist Church, we have two ways to support international missions:

Offering for Global Missions — Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF). When you give to Global Missions, you help plant new churches and share the hope of Christ with people who have never heard the Gospel. You offer food, teach children how to succeed in school, and help refugees adapt and thrive in their new homes.
