
#### **Keith's Korner**



#### **Update from the Stewardship Committee:**

Recently, in the February Church Conference, the Stewardship Committee recommended that Boiling Springs Baptist Church begin raising funds to replace 117 windows in our educational space at \$500 each (total of \$58,500). Approval of replacing the windows came first and then approval was also given to begin raising the needed funds for this project.
