Keith's Korner

God is on the move to...

Several weeks back, when I was giving Roger, Candy and Betsy my sermon plans for the next few weeks, I wasn't quite sure how I was going to end our "God on the Move" sermon series and so I left the last sermon title in the series incomplete. I had every intention of filling this in before the information was communicated to the church, but it went to press as the sermon being, "God on the Move to…"

As this sermon came up on April 28, I thought it most appropriate to leave the title the way I had accidentally left it, incomplete. When we surrender our will and lives to God, we don't know where God moving in us will lead. We don't know what His moving will lead us towards, and we don't know how His moving will play out regarding our future. This relationship we have with God is a lifelong journey of discipleship. The aim is for us to be presented as mature in Christ (Colossians 1:28) because we have taken on His character.

Eugene Peterson's paraphrase of Paul's words in Romans 12:1-2 read, "So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

How is God moving in and through your life? Are you open to God's movement as He is trying to make you more like Jesus today than you were yesterday? How would you personally write the ending to, "God is on the move in me to...?" A few thoughts as a I close...

First, thanks to all who serve and lead in so many ways here at Boiling Springs Baptist. Your service and care for what you do does not go unnoticed.

Second, your tithe and financial gifts to the regular offering and ongoing work of Boiling Springs Baptist church supports missionaries here in the states and around the world. Also, your faithful giving allows the ministries of Boiling Springs Baptist church to continue here in the community. The last several weeks we have fallen behind in our needed weekly giving, and with the summer weeks upon us very soon, let's together help make May a good month.




