Adult Ministry Fall Plans

On October 10 the Adult Ministry will be sponsoring a trip to Flat Rock Playhouse to see *Smoke on the Mountain* which is an “inspiring, funny, and endearing musical celebration of bluegrass, gospel, and hymns. Set in Mount Pleasant, North Carolina around 1938, *Smoke on the Mountain* takes audiences back to an old-time musical revival with beloved songs such as ‘Rock of Ages,’ ‘The Church in the Wildwood,’ and ‘A Wonderful Time Up There.’ Audiences can expect to tap their toes along with traditional and uplifting music that brings us all together.” Reservations are now closed. We will meet at the church at 11:30 am to travel to the Playhouse and will have an early dinner after the musical.

Our regular October gathering will be held on Tuesday, October 22 in the Fellowship Hall at 12:30 pm. She has played the piano for 73 years and got her start on the instrument by taking lessons at age 7 after listening to a Christian radio station out of Long Beach, California. 
